

Pali and Prærit, properly so called, are distinct. It is nevertheless true, that, being cognate dialects, they are often confounded under the same designations: A Pali work is in Hindustan denominated either Magadhi or Prærit. A Prærit one is beyond the Ganges called Magadhi.
