

1792. The officer, who had been sent to the Hankey, returned in
 June 6. the night, the fears of the Portuguese governor were dissipated,
 7th and I was suffered to return to my ship early the next morning;
 I found that the Calypso had joined her consorts the preceding
 day, having experienced an event calamitous to the individuals
 immediately concerned, discouraging to their associates, and in-
 jurious though not fatal to the welfare of the colony. At this
 time there were not any sick on board the Hankey.
