This Institution was organized by the President and Faculty of Georgetown College in May, 1851, under the authority of the law of Congress passed in March, 1815, conferring upon Georgetown College the rights and privileges of a university. The college buildings are owned by the faculty, and are situated at the intersection of F and 12th streets, and have a central and commanding location. They contain lecture-rooms of large size and approved construction; a well-furnished museum; a convenient and well-lighted dissecting-room; together with all the other apartments found in well arranged college buildings.

It is located on Kendall Green, near the junction of M and Boundary streets, and was incorporated in 1857. The facade of the front building is built of pressed brick and dressed brown free-stone, sixty-six feet in length, twenty-eight in width, and four stories high.
