The work will consist of the collection known as Mr. Moore's „Irish Melodies,“ illustrated with one hundred and sixty designs by Mr. Maclise, engraved in facsimile of the original drawings (a few of them being etched by himself), and every page surrounded with an ornamental border. The text, with the exception of the notes and prefatory matter, will be engraved on steel plates, by Mr. Becker's patent process.

The work will be published in October, in One Volume, Imperial Octavo, with One Hundred and Sixty Illustrations, in Boards, Price Three Guineas.
