

### Personalnachrichten.

Am 7. Januar ist wieder ein verdienter und weit geschätzter Veteran des deutschen Buchhandels, Herr Christian Friedrich Winter in Heidelberg, 84 Jahr alt aus dem Kreise der Lebenden geschieden; er war ausgezeichnet durch vielseitige Bildung, einen zarten Sinn für alles Edle und Schöne, und besaß die Manneszierden ächten Freimuths und felsenfester Ueberzeugungstreue.

Winter war früher Kaufmann und trat in den Buchhandel, indem er (1815) an die Stelle seines Jugendfreundes Zimmer (der aus innerem Antrieb als etablierter und bedeutender Buchhändler noch Theologie studierte und Geistlicher wurde) in die Handlung Mohr und Zimmer in Heidelberg eintrat. Das Geschäft erhielt die Firma Mohr und Winter und wurde bis zum Jahr 1822 fortgeführt, wo sich die beiden Theilhaber trennten, und Mohr sowohl als Winter Verlag und Sortiment unter ihrem Namen führten. Im Jahre 1835 verkaufte er sein Sortimentsgeschäft an seinen zweiten Sohn Karl, und ebenso im Jahre 1839 den Verlag an seine Söhne Anton und Christian; seitdem lebte er von allen buchhändlerischen Geschäften zurückgezogen.

Bei seinen Mitbürgern stand er in hohem Ansehen und bekleidete im Laufe der Jahre viele Ehrenämter.

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
