

In Oesterreich erscheinen gegenwärtig 284 Zeitungen; davon sind 90 politischen und 104 nichtpolitischen Inhalts. In Wien werden 70 Zeitungen verlegt, nämlich 16 politische und 54 nichtpolitische.

Bis zum 3. Januar sind von der Broschüre „Le Pape et le Congrès“ nahe an 70,000, und von Thackeray's „Cornhill Magazine“ bis den 31. Decbr. 60,000 Exemplare abgesetzt worden. Für letzteres hat Mr. Tennyson ein Gedicht mit der Ueberschrift „Tithon“ geschrieben, wofür der poeta laureatus dem Athesnäum zufolge eine Guinee für die Zeile empfängt.

In Rußland sind nach dem Berichte des Unterrichtsministers im Jahr 1858 1577 Originalwerke, 284 Uebersetzungen und 165 periodische Schriften erschienen, und 1,614,874 Bände eingeführt worden. Das Warschauer Censurcomité hat von 645 Werken 556 zum Druck verstattet, und in Polen sind aus dem Ausland 173,857 Bände eingeführt worden.
