* * * *THIS Volume contains a Collation with the Curetonian Codex of the palimpsest MS. of the Four Gospels in Syriac discovered by Mrs. Lewis and Mrs. Gibson, in 1892, in the Monastery of St. Catherine on Mt. Sinai, and here styled 'Lewisianus'. All the discrepancies between the two texts are noted, and select variants have been added from the Peshitto when they happen to throw light on those discrepancies. The Editor is indebted to Mrs. Lewis for permission to include the additional readings published by her in the present year, and has added (in footnotes to the Peshitto readings) variants in the Sixth-Century MS. of the Peshitto Gospels (now in the Vatican Library, Guillian's 40) as compared with the printed text.*

The Editor in a Latin Preface explains the principles by which he has been guided in his Collation, and indicates briefly the more important points on which it is hoped that it will be found useful for purposes of New Testament textual criticism.
