Giovanni Segantini

Giovanni Segantini — the only great Alpine Painter died on Sept. 28. 1899 on the Summit of the Schafberg, in the Engadine. In this sumptuous volume M. Luigi Villari produces a Life of the Artist which will render superfluous any further efforts. The Book appeal sequally to the Artist, the Student of Psychology, and the lay reader. The whole of the Plates are reproduced direct from the Original Paintings and cover the entire period of Segantini's Art — his early career as the Millet of the Prealpi' of Lombardy — his works as the Interpreter of Nature in High Places — his final period of Symbolism.

The History of his artistic development is given at length from the time when the works of a mother mourning her dead child. "If only I had some one to make his portrait for me!" moved the young Swineherd to his first efforts, until the day when he died on the mountains a martyr to the art, which was the theme of discussion in every artistic centre of Europe.

The Psychological details are of unusual interest as showing the tremendous effects of great but undigested ideas upon an untrained mind.

The Biography is compiled largely from hitherto unpublished letters, and much is given in Segantinis' own words and style which are of almost scriptural simplicity. His mental activities, by no means confined to artistic subjects yet running in channels which at once betray their origins, have left a highly original record of views upon subjects as various as Socialism — The Musical Drama (a curious and original suggestion for the Book of an opera is given) — Rights of Woman — and a trenchant exposure of the vanity of the dreams of those who imagine that war can ever cease from off the earth.

The Book is essentially one to excite the heariest Interest and Criticism, and will undoubtedly enjoy a wide circulation.
