## St. Petersburg Philharmonic Orchestra

**Yuri Temirkanov, Music Director & Principal Conductor**

**Vadim Repin, Violin**

Russia's oldest symphony orchestra, and the first to tour the West, the internationally renowned institution that we now call the St. Petersburg Philharmonic Orchestra (formerly the Leningrad Philharmonic), was first established in 1882 by decree of Tsar Alexander II, and founded anew in 1917 as Russia's first State Orchestra. Under the leadership since 1988 of Principal Conductor and Music Director Yuri Temirkanov, who brings his insightful and powerfully emotional performance style to the podium, the Orchestra is renowned for its virtuosity and lyric breadth, impassioned performances, and as being without peer in the Russian repertoire.

28-year old Siberian-born Vadim Repin dazzled the world at age 17 by winning Belgium's coveted Queen Elisabeth Prize. Proclaimed by Yehudi Menuhin as "Simply the best, the most perfect violinist I have ever heard," he is hailed as "the foremost young violinist to have emerged from Russia since the days of Heifetz."

A favorite with BSO and Tanglewood audiences, the exuberant and electrifying Spanish-German Principal Guest Conductor Rafael Frühbeck de Burgos is one of the world's most respected and award-winning conductors.

Just 12 years old when she won first prize at the International Yehudi Menuhin Violin Competition, 21-year-old Munich-born Julia Fischer is among today's top violin soloists, winning global acclaim as "not a talent, but a full-fledged phenomenal violinist," (Die Welt). Miss Fischer plays the 1716 Stradivarius "Booth," on loan from the Nippon Music Foundation.
