

MICHAEL SANDERLING CONDUCTOR | ARWEINYDD

Born and educated in Berlin, MICHAEL SANDERLING is one of the most highly sought-after conductors of his generation. Many engagements with leading orchestras and a highly successful artistic collaboration with the renowned Dresden Philharmonic have earned Sanderling an international reputation as a conductor.

Sanderling opened his tenure as
Principal Conductor of the Dresden
Philharmonic at the beginning of the 2011–
12 season and will continue in this capacity
through the 2018–2019 season. He was

Conductor of the Kammerakademie Potsdam from 2006 to 2010.

Sanderling has conducted many of the world's leading orchestras, among them Zurich's Tonhalle Orchestra, the Yomiuri Nippon Symphony Orchestra Tokyo, the Konzerthausorchester Berlin, the Munich Philharmonic, the Staatskapelle Dresden, Bamberg Symphony, the Radio Symphony Orchestras of Stuttgart, Munich, Cologne, Hamburg, Leipzig and Hannover, the Strasbourg Philharmonic Orchestra and the Netherlands Philharmonic Orchestra.
