While executing this work, I did not expect that I should be able to secure perfect accuracy, but I am able to say, when the volume is finished, that I have put in requisition all the means within my reach, to secure an end so desirable. As it is, I submit the work to the student with the hope that it will prove a useful guide in the study of American Geology.
