## Third Subspecies.

Malleable Copper-glance or Malleable Vitreous Copper-ore.

## External Characters.

Its colour is steel-grey.

Internally it is strongly glimmering.

The fracture is even.

It becomes shining in the streak, and the colour is changed to lead-grey.

It is malleable.

## Geographic Situation.

Specific gravity, 5.099.

It is a rare mineral, having been hitherto found only in the mines of Catharinenburg in Siberia.

## Observations.

Colour, lustre, fracture, and malleability, distinguish it from the Compact and Foliated subspecies; and its inferior malleability distinguishes it from Silver-glance or Sulphureted Silver-ore.
