IRON.

It occurs in a bed of magnetic ironstone, along with calcareous-spar and hornblende, in Bjelke's mine in Nordmark, near Philipstadt in Wermeland.

Observations.

It was discovered by Messrs Henry, Gahn and Clason, during a mineralogical journey through Wermeland.

THE most considerable Iron-mines in the world, are those in Great Britain, and France: the next are the Russian, Swedish, and Austrian; the others in the order of their relative magnitude, are in the United States of America, Prussia, Kingdom of Westphalia, Spain, the Danish States, Bavaria, including the Tyrol, and the Kingdom of Saxony.
