The varieties with earthy fracture adhere to the tongue.

Chemical Characters.

It is infusible, without addition, before the blowpipe; with glass of borax it is reduced, and the glass acquires a hyacinth-red colour; and it is insoluble in cold nitric acid.

Constituent Parts.

It is conjectured to be an Arsenate of Nickel.

Geognostic Situation.

It occurs in veins in primitive and fleetz rocks, along with copper-nickel, and black nickel ore, and other ores.

Geographic Situation.

It occurs at Leadhills and Wanlockhead; at Alva in Stirlingshire, and in Linlithgowshire; at Andreasberg in the Hartz; Riegelsdorf; in Saxony; and at Allemont in France.
