The second half of the First Volume, illustrated with twenty-two Engravings, executed by the first Artists, will appear in April; and will contain, besides a variety of articles in Biography, Topography, Statistics, and Miscellaneous Literature, the following extensive treatises: viz. Anatomy (vegetable), Annulties, Annulosa, (including, under that head, a view of several of the most interesting classes of Animals), Arithmetic (its history and theory), Arts, Asia, Assaying, Assurances, Astronomy, Atomic-theory, Attraction, and Australasia.

In order to give the Public all due confidence in the care and ability with which the Work will be composed, the names of those who have contributed to each Volume will be given on its conclusion, with references to their particular contributions.
