

*(c) Pulley Drives*

Pulley drives are firmly attached to various types of tractors. They may also be supplied as accessories. The drive is effected by the tractor gearbox and is designed in such a way that full engine power can be transmitted. The speed varies between 1,000 and 1,500 r.p.m.

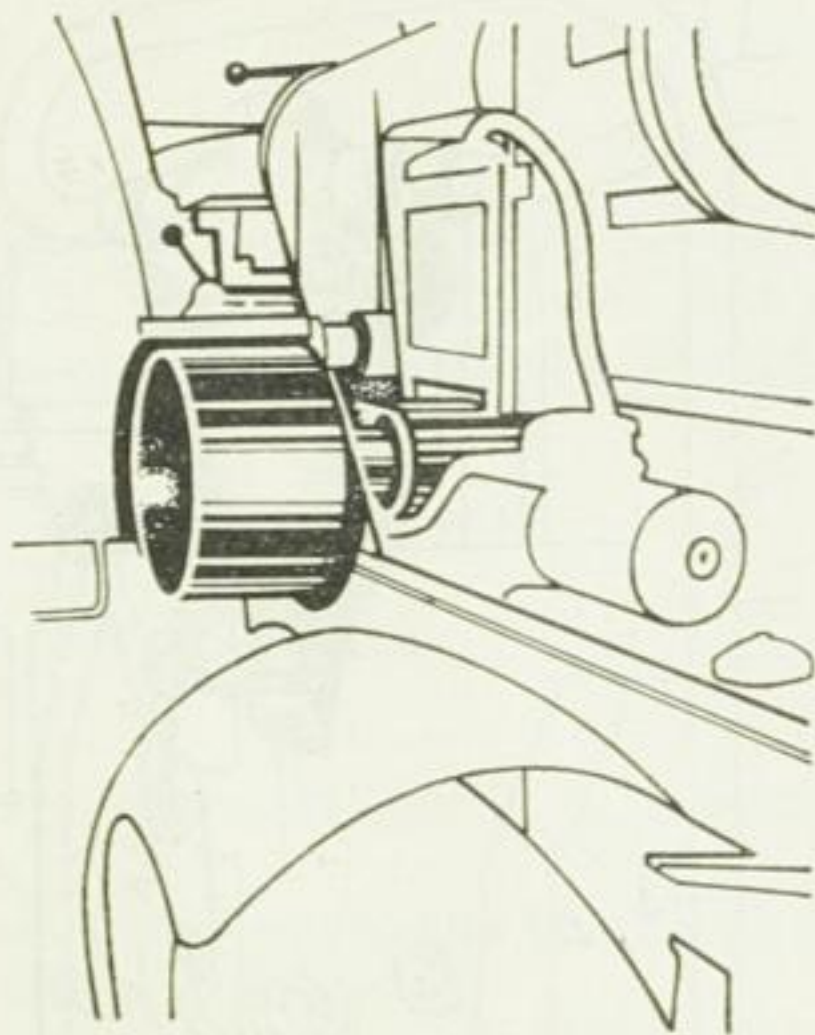


Fig. 311. Pulley drives

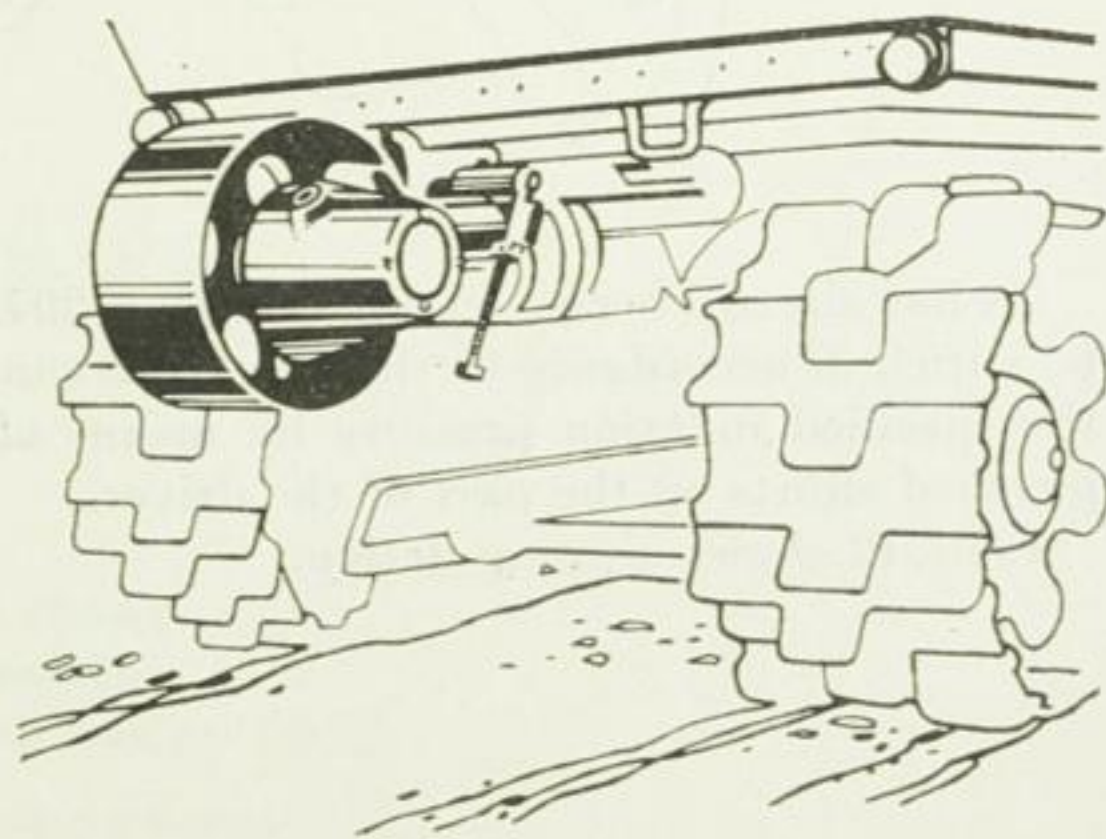


Fig. 311 shows two pulley drive designs. The control lever for putting the drive into operation is normally arranged close to the driver's seat. Before putting a pulley drive into operation, it should be checked for proper oil supply. When operating the pulley drive special care should be taken to prevent accidents.
