LATEST TELEGRAMS.

London, November 27. The Tribune's New York correspondent cables that the shareholders of the Standard Oil Company are planning the construction of railways in Bolivia, which will open up extensive rubber districts. The outlay is estimated at seven million pounds sterling.

The Times correspondent in Tokio reports that the Japanese have decided to bridge the Yalu river at Yongampho. The bridge will be 3,239 feet long, and cost two million yen; it will be completed at the same time as the railway from Widschu to Mukden.-It is officially stated that the enquiry into the cause of the sinking of the battle-ship "Mikasa" on the 12th of September 1905 entirely exonerates the officers and crew of the ship from blame, and proves convincingly that the explosion was caused by ignition arising out of the decomposition of chemicals.

Paris, November 27. Inventories will be taken today in twelve churches in Nantes. As serious disturbances are feared, the garrison has been reinforced.

Warsaw, November 27. A central organisation of the Social Democrat revolutionary party has been discovered here, and the members of it are in custody. A party of 299 political prisoners started for North and East Russia last night.

Portsmouth, November 27. The Naval Court Martial assembled for the trial of men concerned in the disturbance on the 4th instant in the Naval Barracks, today sentenced another stoker to six months imprisonment for refusing to obey orders. Buenos Ayres, November 27. The Leprosy Con-

ference assembled here has expressed the view that all cases of leprosy should be reported, and that every case should be properly treated; that, if necessary, compulsory measures should be taken to enforce those obligations.

Manilla, November 27. Reuter reports that, of 24 prisoners who were inoculated, by way of experiment, with cholera poison, 10 have died. The doctors who instituted the experiment say that the cholera poison was infected with bubonic plague matter. The Governor General has acquitted the doctors concerned from guilt and announced that he will take care that the families of the deceased prisoners are protected from want.

Copenhagen, November 27. The former Custodian of the Rosenborg Museum, Steffensen, has been convicted of theft and fraud and sentenced to two years imprisonment. The value of the articles stolen by him from the Museum is estimated at 16,000 kronen.
