CLASS I.

1. ADRAGNA, BARON G. *Trapani*.—Salt.
2. AGOGNA AND BROVELLO MINING Co. *Palanza (Novara)*.—Argentiferous lead ore.
3. ALDISEO, G. & Co. *Turin (Iron-works at Bard, Val d'Aosta)*.—Iron rod: gun barrels, wrought while cold.
4. ANGHIRELLI, G. *Montalcino (Sienna)*.—Floating bricks, made of “mountain meal” (siliceous skeletons), from Monte Amiata.
5. ARRIGONI, A. *Varese (Milan)*.—Peat.
6. BARBA TROYSE, G. *Spezia (Genoa)*.—Ores of manganese. Decomposed metamorphic jasper, for hydraulic cement (pozzolana).
7. BELTRANI, G. *Trani (Terra di Bari)*.—Limestone and tufa.
8. BELTRAMI, COUNT P. *Cagliari*.—Lead slags of ancient smelting works, and pig of lead obtained from them. Ores of lead, manganese, iron, and copper. Refractory clay, hydraulic lime, lignite.
9. BENTIVOGLIO, CAV. C. *Modena*.—Lime.
10. BIRAGHI, G. & Co., *Milan*.—Lignite.
11. BOLOGNA MINERAL Co. *Bologna*.—Copper pyrites and purple copper ore from the mine of Bisano, with gangue, &c. Serpentinite, steatite, &c.
12. BOTTINO Co. *Leghorn*.—Argentiferous and other ores of lead, from the mine of Bottino. Specimens illustrating the smelting process. Lead, refined copper, and refined silver. Model of the apparatus employed for transporting the ores.
13. BOUGLEUX, F. *Leghorn*.—Millstones of quartzose rock.
14. BOUQUET & SERPIERI, *Cagliari (Smelting-works at Domusnovas and Flumini, Cagliari)*.—Ancient slags. Pigs of lead from Domusnovas and Flumini Maggiore.
15. BRESCIA ATHENÆUM.—Specimens of the rocks and ornamental stones of the province.
16. BUCCI, G. *Campobasso (Molise)*.—Campobasso marble.
17. BURGARELLA, A. *Trapani*.—Sulphur.
18. CAGLIARI SUB-COMMITTEE FOR THE EXHIBITION.—Specimens of building stone.
19. CALZA CRAMER, G. *Grugliasco (Turin)*.—Peat pressed into moulds.
20. CHIAVARI ECONOMIC SOCIETY, *Chiavari (Genoa)*.—Slates for various purposes, from Lavagna quarries, Chiavari.
21. CHIAVENNI SUB-COMMITTEE FOR THE EXHIBITION.—Gypsum, and limestone, from Madesimo, near Chiavenna.
22. CHIOSTRI, L. *Pomarance (Pisa)*.—Specimens of rocks found in the neighbourhood of Pomarance and Libbiano: geological map, &c.
23. COCCHI CAV. BROTHERS, *Florence*.—Jasper from Giarreto, Val di Magra; limestone, hydraulic lime, gypsum, plaster of Paris.
24. COJARI Avv. V. *Fivizzano (Massa-Carrara)*.—Copper ore from S. Giorgio mine, Ajola, Fivizzano; statuary, and other marble, from Equi, Fivizzano.
25. CORBI ZOCCHI, C. *Sienna*.—Sienna earth.
