27. COSTANZO, C. *Catania*.—Sulphur, crude and manufactured, from the solfatara of Cugno, &c.
28. COSTANZO, L. *Catania*.—Sulphuriferous marl, from the solfatara of Estricello, &c.
29. CURIONI, PROF. G. *Milan*.—Casting sand for iron furnaces.
