

lesson. In addition, one example in arithmetic from one lesson to another.

CLASS 5.—Two passages from the Bible, and a verse of a song or small piece of poetry, to be learnt by heart; six lines in print to be copied out, and an exercise in style, every week. Words or short sentences to be copied out, from one grammar lesson to another. A few arithmetic examples from one lesson to another. In the *Bürgerschulen*, in addition, are some French vocabularies to be learnt, and some lines of French to be read through, from one French lesson to another.

CLASSES 4 AND 3.—Every week, from two to three verses from the Bible, one to two verses from a song, and a short extract from the Catechism, or of a poem, are to be learnt by heart, and an essay in style to be written. Grammatical exercises to be written out, and some examples, from one lesson to another. (For *Bürgerschulen*: French exercises, and essays in the geometrical copy-book, from one lesson to another.)

CLASSES 2 AND 1.—Some passages from the Bible, verses of songs, and an extract from the Catechism or of a poem, to be learnt by heart every week, as well as an essay in
