lesson. In addition, one example in arithmetic from one lesson to another.

CLASS 5.—Two passages from the Bible, and a verse of a song or small piece of poetry, to be learnt by heart; six lines in print to be copied out, and an exercise in style, every week. Words or short sentences to be copied out, from one grammar lesson to another. A few arithmetic examples from one lesson to another. In the Bürgerschulen, in addition, are some French vocabularies to be learnt, and some lines of French to be read through, from one French lesson to another.

CLASSES 4 AND 3.—Every week, from two to three verses from the Bible, one to two verses from a song, and a short extract from the Catechism, or of a poem, are to be learnt by heart, and an essay in style to be written. Grammatical exercises to be written out, and some examples, from one lesson to another. (For Bürgerschulen: French exercises, and essays in the geometrical copy-book, from one lesson to another.)

Classes 2 and 1.—Some passages from the Bible, verses of songs, and an extract from the Catechism or of a poem, to be learnt by heart every week, as well as an essay in
