Wine Merchants.

Seulen, Wall-Strasse 16. Schönrock, Wilsdruffer Strasse. Gerlach, Moritz-Strasse.

The wine of these houses is generally considered good. Gerlach has a very good claret at a low price and enjoys the patronage of many foreign families. — Port wine, the favorite drink of the English, may be in quality equal to that drunk in England, but is so neither in taste nor in flavour. English families, therefore, generally order their Port from England. —

Confectioners.

Trepp, Altmarkt, corner of Scheffel-Strasse. Lässig, Prager-Strasse. Stockfleth, Ferdinand-Platz. Hempel, Prager-Strasse.

They are reputed for a good cup of coffee or chocolate. A great quantity of ice is consumed here during the hot season. Cream ices are to be found only at the first-class confectioners, while water ices (sherbets) are to be met with everywhere, and at very moderate prices.
