of Gothic architecture, presents much that is worthy of being seen, especially the winding staircase of 113 steps, which is considered a master piece of architecture. The cathedral, also a Gothic building with a beautiful spire of open work, contains in its interior to which admission may be had on applying to the clerk living close by, some good stone sculptures, several handsome monuments, painted glass windows, and pictures among which is a valuable production of Lucas Cranach, "the Descent from the cross". A short way from the town is the Porcelain Manufactory. The Porcelain of Meissen is renowned throughout the civilized world. Tickets of admission may be had at the office.
