Jeder baut die Batterie gewissermaßen in sein Spezialgebiet ein, und so entsteht trotz Gleichheit der Bildidee eine interessante Abwechslung in der Gestaltung der gleichartigen Aufgabe, die durchaus anregend ist. C. P. Helck is the next artist. He is a painter who uses a broad brush in his illustrations . . . In the design by Edward L. Chase, a temperamental landscape artist, the battery is presented in a phantastic figure growing out of the lines of an American metropolis. His design attains a heightened degree of interest through the introduction of the mighty tree in the foreground. — H. L. Grout is an illustrator of congested American thoroughfares. Sigurd Skou and Earl Horter also prefer architectural motives. All these artits have worked the battery into their own type of design, and the result, despite the uniformity of idea, is an interesting and stimulating variety in the composition of the same subject.
