The town of Deauville has issued a prospectus de luxe, in which the artist gives free play to his sense of humor in depicting the prominent habitués of the renowned French coast resort.

In Don's theatrical posters, as in all others, he represents his figures either grotesquely caricatured or boldly conventionalised. In proof of this we need only cite the portraits of Georges Carpentier, Les Rowe Sisters, Meg Lemonnier and Régina Fiory. He has also made paintings for hoardings and bill-boards of Maurice Chevalier and Saint Granier.

Besides these he has designed a series of advertisements for the great French seaside resorts, which depict the pleasures and delights of each individual resort in the most captivating fashion—the games on the beach of La Baule, the healing powers of the springs of Contrexéville and the fashionable doings in the mountain heights of Pau.

Finally, hundreds of cover designs for the weekly "Sur la Rivière" testify, in the variety of their subject-matter and the versatility of execution to the fantasy and creative power of this artist.
