EDGAR MILLER, CHICAGO

Edgar Miller, the black-and-white artist and painter of Chicago, is an interesting personality. His prospectuses are so well disciplined in the arrangement of the types that the perfect harmonizing of the freely designed illustration with the typography appears to be a mere matter of course. Miller's wood-cuts approximate to the traditional forms of the European wood-cut. Here, too, we find a happy disposition of black and white. Miller is not purely an advertising artist. The many concessions which this form of art demands of the artist impelled him to seek other fields for his talent. Especially successful are his stained glass windows, a form of design which must be treated in a decorative style closely approximating to that of the wood-cut. Translated by E.T.S.
