Decaris is barely thirty years of age, but he has already created important work and has a considerable reputation.

Those who take an interest in bookbinding and engraving have been watching this young man's career for years. As a fourteen-year-old he already began to neglect his studies in favour of his drawing, and at the age of eighteen he won the "Grand Prix" of Rome, which has never before or since been awarded to so young an artist.
