In order to do justice to his method of work, one must not only consider his advertising designs but also his free creative work, where he is at liberty to give free rein to his lively imagination. He is particularly addicted to philosophical problems which he treats in a most original burlesque fashion peculiar to himself. In one picture, Fate hovers over mankind, disembodied and unearthly, hovers over strong and weak alike and juggles with their destinies. Another allegorical design, illustrating one of the "Cosmic Lyrics" of G. Vinant, represents the birth of the universe: worlds, stars and atoms stream like rain from the fronds of a gigantic fern, chaos takes upon itself a form and becomes
