

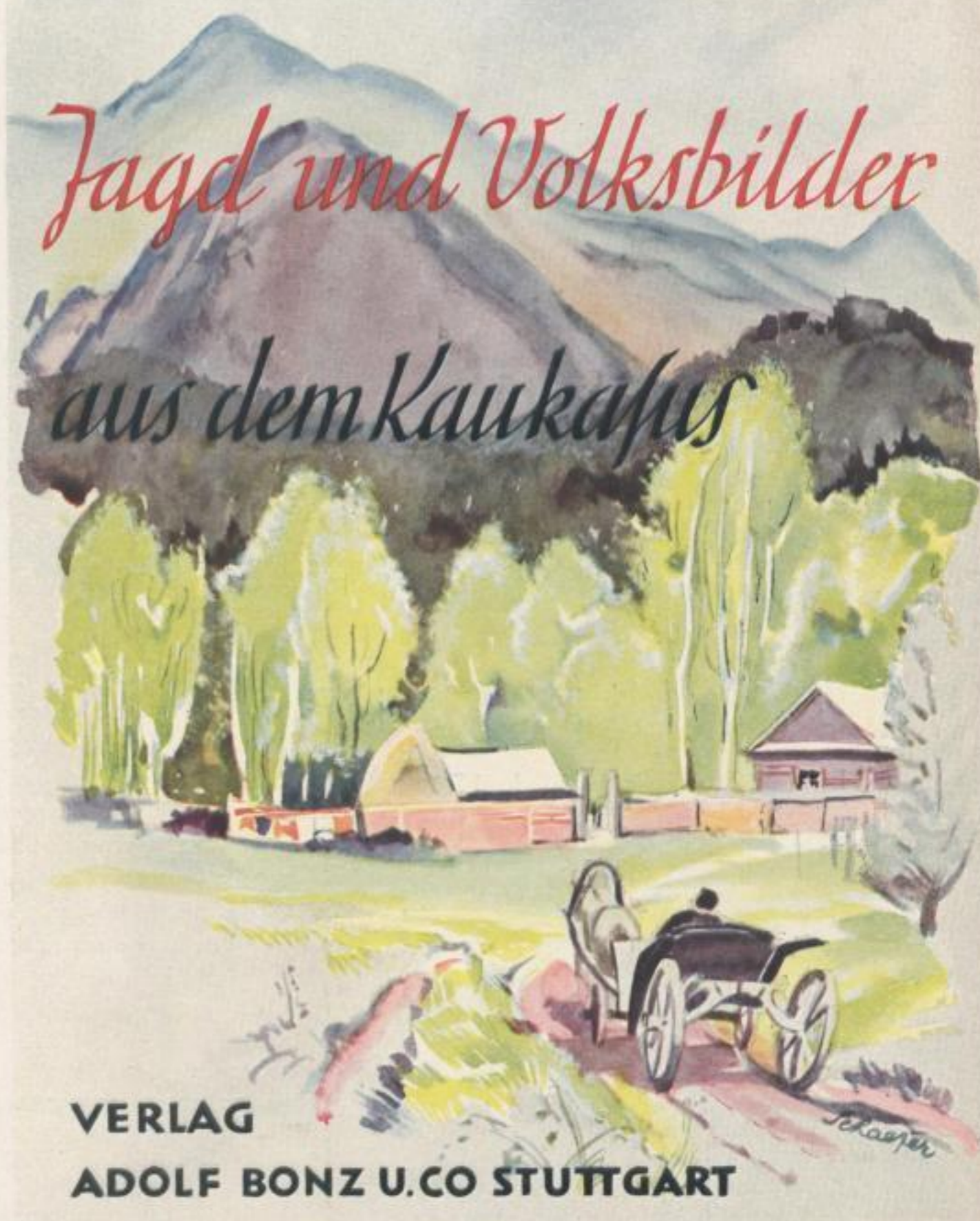

Professor Edmund Schäfer is a teacher at the Kunstgewerbeschule-Ost (School of Arts and Crafts) in Berlin. One would not think so to look at the work reproduced here. There is nothing of the school-master about these designs, as we see even at the first passing glance. The water-color of the young girl is a hasty improvisation, thrown off with a sketchiness which the teacher certainly would not recommend to many of his pupils. A master-hand may venture such facile strokes and perhaps a pupil too, but only under the master's eye. The water-color for the book-cover "Jagd und Volksbilder aus dem Kaukasus" is also done with a light touch—lightness and fluency of line is part of the very being of a water-color—but certain details betray the sure and practised hand.
