POSTER COMPETITION FOR THE JUBILEE OF THE OBER-AMMERGAU PASSION PLAY, 1634-1934

The village of Ober-Ammergau has instituted a competition open to all artists working in Bavaria for a poster celebrating the jubilee performances of the Passion Play in 1934. The poster must in some way bear upon the origin of the Passion Play, the vow taken by the residents of Ober-Ammergau in the plague year of 1633. Before the final judgement, the council of judges, consisting of seven experts and two laymen, called attention to the fact that according to the conditions set for the competition, it was not absolutely necessary to represent the idea of the plague year in the design. On the contrary while it was expressly desired that the main stress should be laid upon the taking of the vow, this was not insisted upon. It was unconditionally demanded that the poster design
