

PROPAGANDA EXHIBITION: "HOSPITABLE BADEN"



That active body, "Bund Deutscher Verkehrsverbände und Bäder" has added beautiful exhibition rooms, flooded with light, to its bright and well-arranged information hall in Columbus House, Potsdamer Platz, Berlin. These rooms are allotted in turn to every County Tourist League belonging to the organisation for the display of propaganda relating to its own particular section of the country. At the end of May and beginning of June the exhibit was "Hospitable Baden". It was a seemly survey, arranged without any attempt at cheap and superficial effects, to remind the beholder of the richness and beauty of the wonderful landscapes of the Upper Rhine, the Main, the Neckar and the Bodensee or Lake of Constance, of the Odenwald, the hills of Baden, the Black Forest and the Baar.
