This new book by Dr. Paul Wolff is just as beautiful and interesting as his first book "Meine Erfahrungen mit der Leica". The illustrations are almost unsurpassable in their vividness. The cut of the illustrations and the technical get-up, which was again done by Hans Breidenstein, are excellent. At the end of the book Dr. Paul Wolff explains his method of photography in the mountains. The objective, diaphragm and time of exposure for each of the 76 photographs in the book are given in a special table. His final remarks are also noteworthy. He writes: "Nowhere, either here or elsewhere, have I attempted to play off one camera against the other. At no point have I worried about what others consider right or what they believe.
