culties to the advertising artist than do more decorative designs. Niethammer devotes most of his attention to "thankless" such objects which wins for him the eternal gratitude of many an advertising manager. His wife's work is very charming; her tarsia designs are also in excellent taste. And even if the work does reveal a woman's hand, it displays character, firmness and charm.
