

others also, Olmütz, for instance, and Brixen, Trient, Münster, Osnabrück, Halberstadt. The Augsburg "Reformationskalender" may, in a certain sense, be termed the Protestant counterpart of the canons' kalendar. It was issued on the anniversaries commemorating Luther's nailing of his thesis to the door of the Church at Wittenberg, and the presentation of the Confession of Augsburg to the Diet. Either scenes connected with these events are depicted on the Kalendar or else religious allegories and portraits of Protestant clergy. A municipal counterpart, so to speak, of the cathedral kalendar is to be found in the
