Carl Ludwig Frommel, the versatile painter and copperplate engraver has the honour of having introduced into Germany the technique of steel engraving that was first discovered in England in 1820. In 1825 Frommel established a studio at Karlsruhe. It was the first German art publishing house to produce steel engravings and opened up to this new and only just budding technique a brilliant development as a highly valuable medium of illustration. Large, handsome volumes and portfolios of pictures were published everywhere and in South Germany in particular. Leipzig above all, thanks to the activity of Joseph Meyer, the well-known publisher and founder of the Bibliographical Institute, did much to popularize the steel engraving in Germany.
